

Example of bias (NRK)

28 December 2016 the Minister of Foreign Affairs John Kerry explained six principles he and his president Barack Obama thought were important for a solution.



Obama's principles covered in NRK

1. Sikre og anerkjente internasjonale grenser mellom Israel og en bærekraftig og sammenhengende palestinske stat, basert på 1967-linjene og gjensidig avtalte landbytter.
2. Løsningen må være to stater for to folk – en jødisk og en arabisk. (Tostatsløsning)
3. En løsning for palestinske flyktninger (i all hovedsak etterkommere) må finnes uten at ”den fundamentale karakteren til Israel” blir påvirket.
4. Jerusalem som hovedstad for de to statene.
5. Full avslutning av okkupasjonen, samtidig som Israel garanteres sikkerhet - en palestinsk stat må være demilitarisert.
- 6 En avtale må være permanent – det skal ikke kunne reises nye krav i framtiden.

"Let me emphasize, this is not to say that the settlements are the whole or even the primary cause of this conflict. Of course they are not. Nor can you say that if the settlements were suddenly removed, you'd have peace. Without a broader agreement, you would not. And we understand that in a final status agreement, certain settlements would become part of Israel to account for the changes that have taken place over the last 49 years – we understand that – including the new democratic demographic realities that exist on the ground. They would have to be factored in."






Kun Israel ga framvekst av palestinsk selvstyre

Det har aldri eksistert noen palestinsk stat. Først etter at Israel tok kontroll over Gaza og Vestbredden fikk palestinene etterhvert selvstyre der. I 2005 trakk Israel seg helt ut av Gaza. I 2008 tilbudte Israel tilbaketrekkning fra 97 % av Vestbredden.




Kartforklaring

Dette kartet ble lagt fram i forhandlingene mellom Israel og de palestinske selvstyre-myndighetene høsten 2008. Daværende statsminister i Israel, Ehud Olmert, ønsket å annektere 6,3 prosent av arealet på Vestbredden (blått). Innenfor dette området bor 75 prosent av de jødiske bosetterne. 



1921: Storbritannia skiller ut Transjordan og overgir det til arabisk kontroll, omlag 77 prosent av arealet.




1947: FNs generalforsamling foreslår å dele restområdet i en jødisk og arabisk stat. Araberne sier NEI.




1949: Våpenhvilelinjene gir det jødiske folk suverenitet på ca 18 prosent av mandatområdet fra 1920.




1973: Våpenhvilelinjer etter Jom Kippur-krigen.

Fakta om israelske bosettinger

- Over 700.000 israelske bosettere bor i 237 bosettinger og såkalte utposter på den israelskokkuperte Vestbredden, inkludert Øst-Jerusalem.
- Israel har opprettet 20 industriområder som huser rundt 1.000 fabrikker i de ulovlige bosettingene.
- Israelske bosettere dyrker rundt 93 kvadratkilometer palestinsk jordbruksland, mens boligområdene i bosettingene utgjør rundt 60 kvadratkilometer.
- Israelske myndigheter lokker bedrifter med lav leie, gunstige skatter, subsidier og tilskudd til bosettingene.


Ingen rett til retur

- 1) Returret svekkes jo lengre tid som går. FN og EU mener det har gått for lang tid for noen tilbakevending på Kypros (1974).
- 2) Returret svekkes når den opprinnelige konflikten fortsetter.
- 3) Returret svekkes når nye innbyggere har flyttet inn i området. Jødiske flyktninger fra arabiske land.

Why Iceland was dead wrong to recognize Palestine as a state

On 29 November 2011, the parliament of Iceland passed a resolution that authorized the government to officially recognize the state of Palestine within the 1967 borders. The resolution was passed without opposing votes, although several opposition MPs abstained. Óssur Skarphéðinsson, Minister for Foreign Affairs of Iceland, formally declared Iceland's recognition of the state of Palestine on December 15, 2011.

Montevideo convention 1933

- 1) A permanent population.
- 2) A defined land area.
- 3) One government.
- 4) Capacity to enter into agreements with other countries.

Recognition cannot create a state if it does not exist as a fact on the ground.

The State of Palestine is a fantasy, not a reality.



Countries that have recognized the State of Palestine.

What constitutes a state?

Until such a time as a final settlement is agreed, the putative State of Palestine will have no territory over which it exercises effective sovereignty, its borders will be indeterminate or disputed, its population, actual and potential, undetermined and many of them continuing to live under occupation or in States of refuge.

Demands on new states

1991 - guide for recognition of new states in Eastern Europe and the former Sovjetunion

- respect for rule of law, democracy and human rights

- borders should not be violated

- conflicts should be solved through diplomacy

Jugoslavia

- before recognition, guarantee that they have no territorial demands on neighbouring countries.



Palestinian Authority Basic Law

"Palestine is part of the larger Arab world, and the Palestinian people are part of the Arab nation. Arab unity is an objective that the Palestinian people shall work to achieve." (Art. 1)

Artikkel 4:

"Islam is the official religion in Palestine. Respect for the

sanctity of all other divine religions shall be maintained. The principles of Islamic Shari'a shall be a principal source of legislation.

Arabic shall be the official language."





- MIFF is non-religious and non-partisan.



Not focusing on his own opinions and ideas, but reporting how mainstream Israelis think.


MIFF general assembly 2000 adopted this as a formal information strategy:







We do support Israel because the state has restored the hope and secured the life and future for the Jewish people after they experienced their history's greatest tragedy.


